EU Proposes to Limit Formaldehyde in Certain Toy Materials

On December 18, 2018, the World Trade Organization (WTO) circulated a notification announcing a proposal from the European Union (EU) to restrict formaldehyde in specific toy materials under Appendix C to Annex II to Directive 2009/48/EC, the Toy Safety Directive (TSD).

This draft Commission Directive aims to include, in Appendix C to Annex II to Directive 2009/48/EC, limit values for formaldehyde in polymeric toy material, resin-bonded wood toy material, textile toy material, leather toy material, paper toy material and water-based toy material used in toys intended for use by children under 36 months or in other toys intended to be placed in the mouth.

Proposed limit values for Formaldehyde:

According to the WTO notification (G/TNT/N/EU/635), the draft Directive is proposed to be adopted in the second quarter of 2019 and the proposed date of entry into force is the last quarter of 2020 (18 months after publication in the Official Journal of the EU).

Formaldehyde is classified as carcinogenic category 1B under Regulation (EC) No.1272/2008, a concentration of 0.1% (1,000mg/kg) shall not be exceeded according to point 4(a) of Part III of Annex II to Directive 2009/48/EC before implementation and adoption of the above proposal by the Member States.
